DECLARATION OF PRINCIPLES

1. We believe in Infinite Intelligence (God).

3. We affirm that a correct understanding of such expression and living in accordance therewith, constitute true religion.
4. We affirm that the existence and personal identity of the individual continue after the change called death.
5. We affirm that communication with the so-called dead is a fact scientifically proven by the phenomena of Spiritualism.
6. We believe that the highest morality is contained in the Golden Rule: "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you."
7. We affirm the moral responsibility of individuals, and that we make our own happiness or unhappiness as we obey or disobey Nature's physical and spiritual laws.
8. We affirm that the doorway to reformation is never closed against any soul, here or hereafter.
9. We affirm that the Precepts of Prophecy and Healing are divine attributes proven through Mediumship.

SPIRITUALISM

As defined by the **National Spiritualist Association of Churches (NSAC)** . . .

Spiritualism is the Science, Philosophy and Religion of continuous life, based upon the demonstrated fact of communication, by means of mediumship, with those who live in the Spirit World.

Spiritualism is a Science because it investigates, analyzes and classifies facts and manifestations demonstrated from the Spirit side of life.

Spiritualism is a Philosophy because it studies the Laws of Nature both on the seen and unseen sides of life and bases its conclusions upon present observed facts. It accepts statements of observed facts of past ages and conclusions drawn therefrom, when sustained by reason and by results of observed facts of the present day.

Spiritualism is a Religion because it strives to understand and to comply with the Physical, Mental and Spiritual Laws of Nature, which are the laws of God.

A Spiritualist is one who believes, as the basis of his or her religion, in communication between this and the Spirit World by means of mediumship and who endeavors to mould his or her character and conduct in accordance with the highest teachings derived from such communication.

WELCOME

We are delighted that you are interested in becoming a member of our Church. We ask that you consider the following:

Spiritualism is a beautiful religion, and becoming a member is both a privilege and a responsibility. Consider what you want from the church and what you are willing to give to the church.

Spiritualists recognize God as the Universal Source, the Infinite Spirit. We believe that each of us is an integral part of God. Our philosophy, drawn from this understanding, teaches that the pathway to spiritual growth and positive living comes from taking personal responsibility for one's behavior.

We do not condone the use of tarot cards, Ouija boards, palm reading, crystals, etc. in giving Spirit greetings. As Spiritualists, we believe that our mediums communicate directly with those in Spirit; thus, the use of any tool is unnecessary.

We embrace Jesus as a teacher, a medium and a healer, but not as a personal savior or intermediary. We also embrace other great prophets sent by God to illumine the pathway of Humanity.

We are an organized religious body. We follow the By-Laws of our parent Church, the National Spiritualist Association of Churches (NSAC), as well as the By-Laws of our Church, the Albertson Memorial Church of Spiritualism.

MEMBERSHIP

In order to become a member of Albertson Memorial Church of Spiritualism, you must:

- Have attended Church services for at least three months.
- Be at least 18 years of age, in order to have an adult membership.
- Be wholeheartedly in accordance with the objectives of the Church and the NSAC.
- Have attended at least one Membership Class, which teaches the principles and philosophy of Spiritualism.
- Declare acceptance and belief in the Science, Philosophy and Religion of Spiritualism.
- Embrace the concept of the continuity of life through the demonstration of mediumship.
- Complete an NSAC application form, with membership donation, and present it to the Board of Directors. The donation is suggested at \$50 (this includes the NSAC per-member contribution).

You must be a member for at least three months in order to vote at any Church meeting.

You must be a member for at least one year to be eligible for a seat on the Church Board of Directors.

OUR MINISTRIES

Albertson Memorial Church of Spiritualism is an active and dynamic church. We offer the following:

Sunday Worship: Every Sunday, from 11:00 AM to 12:15 PM. Fellowship and refreshments follow the service.

Education: Our education ministry is wide-ranging and eclectic. We offer classes, workshops, meditation groups and development circles on a variety of subjects which span from traditional Spiritualist concepts, to metaphysical and esoteric ideals and ideas, to more traditional religious teachings.
